MINING ESSENTIAL TO PROGRESS

In the Denver Mining and Financial Record, former Governor William A. Sulzer of New York says:

"Those who decry mining are ignorant of history, or have ulterior purposes to serve. If they know anything about metals they must know that all business, that all industry, that all human progress depends on the mines.

"Show me a people without mines, and I will show you a people deep in the mire of poverty and a thousand years behind the procession of civilization.

"Mining is essential to the progress of civilization. Government statistics show that there has been less money lost in mining than in any other business in our country. These records prove that during the last 50 years the failures in mining have been less than 35 per cent, against more than 67 per cent of failures in other industries.

"Strike down the minor; shackle mining; throttle the mining industry, and civilization will sink back to poverty and stagnation."

EUROPE GOOD COPPER MARKET

The Copper Exports Association organized under the Webb-Pomerene act, which permits American manufacturers to combine to sell goods abroad on terms to compete with foreign manufacturers, measures its success in four directions:

First—It has maintained the price of foreign copper, after allowing for transportation costs, slightly above domestic prices.

Second—The marketing of copper abroad is now being done in an orderly manner.

Third—Speculation in copper has been virtually eliminated.

Fourth—Steps are now being taken to stimulate the consumption of copper abroad.

The United States alone produces 54 per cent of the world's output of copper, and consumes 49 per cent of the total. Europe produces 8 per cent and consumes 44 per cent. These figures are an illustration of the importance which a sustained demand for copper in Europe is to the American producers, and also why every American is interested in laws which strengthen the metal mining industry.

USE THE YARDSTICK

The Tax Digest, published monthly by the California Oaxpayers' Association, under the direction of Dr. Milbank Johnson, outlines a program which citizens of every state have the right to expect their representatives in public office, from justice of the peace to United States senator, will carry out. Here it is:

That every legislator will use the yardstick of economy and efficiency in measuring the value and importance of and the necessity for each legislative proposal.

That legislators will consistently apply the measurement to bills introduced.

That legislators will carefully study all bills referred to their several committees, remembering the great responsibility of recommending measures to their conferees, on the full purpose of which they are not thoroughly informed.

That they will vigorously oppose legislation that does not represent a real need.

That they will to the best of their ability eliminate all superfluous and overlapping machinery in the administration of public business.

That they will give their full support to all measures to place improved business methods in effect in the conduct of government in the state, county and municipality.

That they will view no measure solely from the standpoint of local or sectional interest, but rather as it may affect the state as a whole.

That every legislator will not only welcome but will seek information on all subjects under discussion from those who are prepared to supply it, and who are sincerely interested in

the welfare of the state.

That each legislator will consider himself a trustee for the taxpayers, and the public funds as trust funds, and conserve these funds in the interest of the taxpayer.

That each legislator will consider himself a spokesman and public defender of the taxpayers who have entrusted their affairs to his keeping.

NOTICE FOR BIDS FOR TRANSPORTATION OF HIGH SCHOOL PUPILS TO PATAGONIA UNION HIGH SCHOOL.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids for the transportation of the High School pupils to the PATAGONIA UNION HIGH SCHOOL over the route herein specified, for the school term commencing September 12th, 1927, and lasting for nine and one-half (9½) school months of twenty days each, will be received at Patagonia, Arizona, by the clerk of the Board of Education for the Patagonia Union High School, on or before Tuesday, April 26, 1927, and up to 6 o'clock sharp on said day.

Such bids must be for the purpose of transporting pupils to the Patagonia Union High School from the Canille school house along the main highway through Elgin and Sonoita to Patagonia, a distance of approximately 30 miles, and return along the same route. Said transportation bus to pick up any and all eligible pupils who present themselves along the route at the schedule time. But to run on a set schedule which will unload the pupils at the Patagonia Union High School not later than 9:00 A. M. and to leave on the return trip not later than 4:30 P. M. unless specially arranged for, and to run every school day.

Bus for transportation to be any standard enclosed body built for passenger service, with longitudinal seats for 25 children or 18 adults, on an extended chassis of any standard geared type.

The successful bidder must contract to keep bus in good running condition at all times and to furnish all necessary oil, gas, tires and repairs for the same, free of all charge to the PATAGONIA UNION HIGH SCHOOL district.

Successful bidder must abide by all rules of the Corporation Commission of this State as to permits, insurance, etc., and must bear the expense of the same.

Bids must be made on a set monthly payment basis, based on a school month of twenty school days, bidder to make such reports to the clerk of the Board of Education as may be requested.

All bids must be accompanied by a cashier's check for Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into contract with the Board of Education of the Patagonia Union High School, and a bond of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars will be required from the successful bidder to insure the faithful performance of the contract.

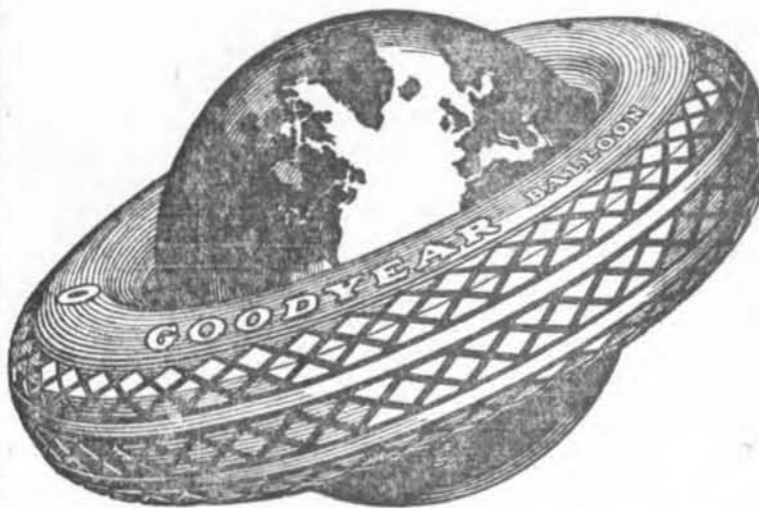

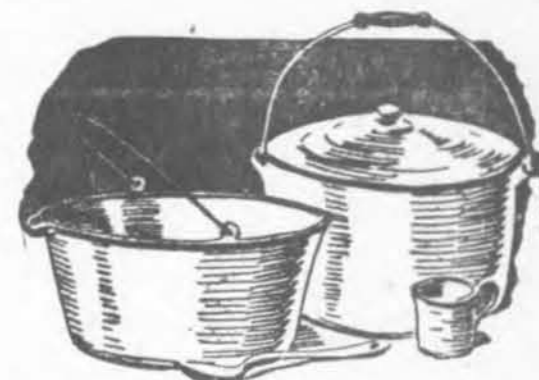

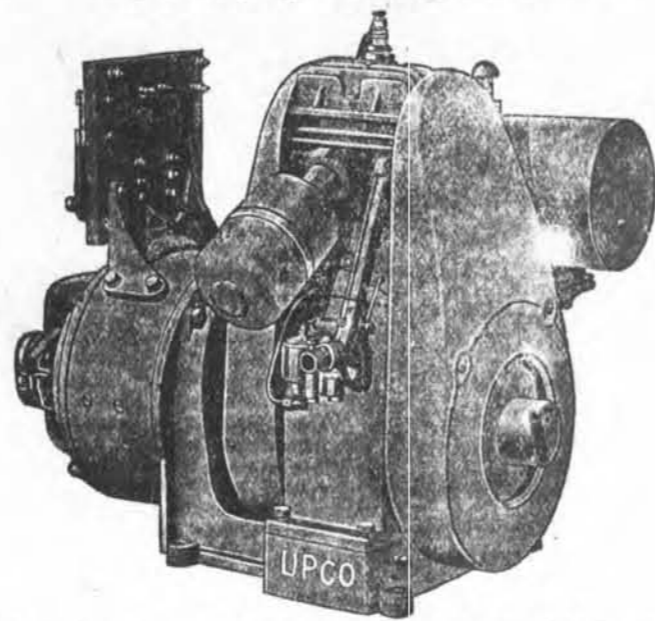
